ANZ Community Ball raises \$150,000 for local charities

ANZ is proud to announce that this year's Community Ball in Adelaide was a resounding success, with fundraising initiatives on the night raising over \$150,000 for local charities while celebrating the best of South Australia's produce and talent.

Returning to the Adelaide Oval for 2025, over 400 attendees participated in various fundraising activities, including live and silent auctions, a SkyCity Balloon Pop fundraising initiative, and a car raffle provided by Peter Kittle Toyota. The evening featured music from award-winning cover band, The Cast, and entertainment from magician and mentalist, Matt Tarrant.

The funds raised will significantly benefit the services our charity partners deliver, providing much-needed support to their respective communities.
